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BID SPECIFICATIONS FOR LIMESTONE

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Hillsdale at their office at 1919 Hudson Road (M-99) southeast of Hillsdale, Michigan, until 10:45 a.m. local time, Thursday, March 29, 2018, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing and delivering our 2018 season's requirements of crushed limestone to locations within Hillsdale County as specified herein.

Specifications

The county road commission uses a variety of crushed limestone for maintenance work and/or construction projects on an as-needed basis including MDOT 23A, MDOT 21AA, Ohio #2, Ohio #4 and Ohio type D riprap. The limestone must meet current MDOT or ODOT specifications. The limestone must be loaded and weighed in double-bottom (40-50 ton) trucks at a limestone quarry of the bidder's choice (specify same on bid sheet). Copy of weigh slips are required. The limestone shall be delivered in double-bottom truck load quantities to the road commission stock yard on M-99 or various job sites anywhere in Hillsdale County. The bid unit prices shall include both limestone cost and delivery charges as one price per ton for each item bid. Orders will be placed by phone usually 24-48 hours prior to the desired delivery time. Estimated quantities of 23A and 21AA combined for county stockyard is 500 tons. Estimated quantities of #2, #4 & type D riprap combined for county stockyard is 300 tons. In addition, several townships are interested in purchasing and stockpiling 23A limestone in their townships for the county's use in patching on gravel roads. Each township will do between 500 - 2,000 tons each.

Bid prices for crushed limestone shall be firm for one year from date of bid regardless of quantity actually ordered. Fuel surcharges will not be allowed. Specify the length of time for which your bid is firm. Payment will be made within 30 days after receipt of invoices. Bids must be submitted on bid sheets provided by the road commission. Bids are to be submitted in sealed envelopes clearly marked with the words "**Limestone Bid**".

Title VI Compliance

The HCRC, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of gender, disability, race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Award of Bid

Bids for our season's requirements of crushed limestone may be awarded to one bidder, several bidders, or all bidders. If the bids are awarded to several or all bidders, the road commission would then choose the bidder that is the most economical in delivered cost and can meet our delivery needs to the particular job being performed. Unit prices will govern regardless of increase or decrease in quantities. We will not guarantee a minimum quantity to be ordered.

This bid may be extended an additional year(s) upon the mutual written consent of the road commission and the successful bidder(s).

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive details in specifications, to waive irregularities in the bidding, and to accept the bid(s) which in their opinion is in the best interest of the road commission.
